Meeting Host Guide

Use this guide to build a meeting agenda and guide community discussions to discover actions you can take in your community to support the recommendations of Education Re-Imagined: 12 Actions for Education. You may wish to use the below process as a meeting agenda or to help guide your community discussions.

Before sharing the handout:

Read the one sentence summary of the theme to the group.

Ask the group to have a partner or small group conversation about what they predict the recommendations and data will include.

While looking at the handout:

Some questions for groups to talk about:

- Is there anything surprising to you?
- What questions do you still have? Who might be able to answer those for the group?

Questions for considerations and what can you do:

As you discuss these, either in smaller groups or as a whole group:

- Are there specific considerations that your group should bring into the larger conversation?
- How might you share these considerations with others?
- What might an advocacy plan look like?

Is this a group that meets regularly? What commitments might you make to do before you meet again?

- Call your MLA, attend a school community council meeting, write a letter, engage your stakeholders in conversation?
