Re-Imagine Education Reference Committee to Release 12 Actions for Education

For Immediate Release – Friday, November 1, 2019

REGINA – The Re-Imagine Education Reference Committee will release its recommendations to the Provincial Government and the public on Monday, November 4. The report is the result of extensive province-wide consultations designed to build a vision for the future of public education in Saskatchewan.

The report includes 12 Actions for Education in four categories: The Learning Environment, Decision Making in Education, Legislation & Policy in Education and Education Funding.

The Actions for Education are based on input from more than 6,000 students, parents, teachers, and those not typically involved in these discussions, including business and community organizations and those for whom the traditional education system did not work.
